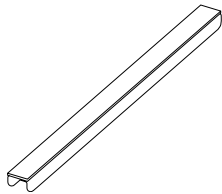


Public Baths in Hotel Oderberger, Berlin

Built in 1902 in the Prenzlauer Berg district, this former public bathhouse has undergone extensive renovation and is now a stylish historic boutique hotel with 70 rooms, two apartments and five tower suites. The heart of the hotel is the cathedral-like swimming pool in Neo-Renaissance style that is not just used for swimming. The unusual location now offers space for events with up to 400 people, as well as providing a tasteful ambience with a swimming pool and spa area for recreation and relaxation. The shower area has been elegantly refurbished with a CeraLine F channel, which offers a striking modern contrast.
